We are also interested in articles that explore solutions and strategies for addressing hate manifested within and against various cultural settings. A special invitation is extended to scholars from disciplines such as history, psychology, philosophy, women's studies, cultural studies, anthropology, political science, economics, literature, rhetoric, and religious studies.

Submissions are due by May 1, 2005 and should be between 5000-10,000 words. Submissions should be one hard copy and an electronic copy in MS Word format. Please do not submit PDF files.
